


sponsors for the event were: a) That Al Salasil (GUST campus bookstore) and b) Arabian Advanced Systems (an online resource provider).

ULRICH'SWEB GLOBAL SERIALS DIRECTORY

Ulrichsweb is an easy to search source of detailed information on more than 300,000 periodicals (also called serials) of all types: academic and scholarly journals, e-journals, peer-reviewed titles, popular magazines, newspapers, newsletters, and more.

It covers more than 900 subject areas. Ulrich's records provide data points such as ISSN, publisher, language, subject, abstracting & indexing coverage, full-text database coverage, tables of contents, and reviews written by librarians.





SELF CHECK-OUT SERVICE IN THE LIBRARY

As part of the ongoing commitment to serve the library users in an effective manner, we now have 'self-checkout service' at the Library. Users can borrow books on their own through the Self Check-out machine located in front of the general collection stacks. In order to use a Self Check-out machine, you need GUST ID and the book(s) you wish to borrow.

To formalize the check-out, you must first enter your GUST ID, and then the PIN which is the last 4-



digits of your Civil ID number, thereafter place the book or books on the machine. When all books have been checked out a receipt will be printed with the due date.



NO FOOD & DRINK

The Library is a place for study and reflection, hence eating and drinking is discouraged.
